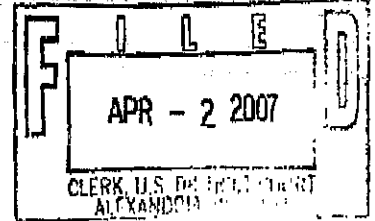

For the reasons stated in open court, it is hereby  
ORDERED that Defendants' Motion for Reconsideration and/or  
Clarification of the Court's Ruling on Defendants' Motion for  
Summary Judgment (docket #s 175 and 176) be and is DENIED, and it  
is further

ORDERED that Plaintiffs' Motion for Partial Summary Judgment  
(docket #178) be and is GRANTED, and it is further


ORDERED that defendants' Motion in Limine No. 1 (Hearsay in  
Publication) (docket #167) be and is held in abeyance until  
further Order of the Court; Motion in Limine No. 2 (Settlement  
Communications) (docket #168) be and is DENIED; Motion in Limine  
No. 3 (Late Produced Documents) (docket #169) be and is DENIED;  
Motion in Limine No. 4 (Evidence and Testimony About Actual  
Damages) (docket #170) be and is GRANTED to the extent that  
evidence of actual damages disclosed after the close of discovery  
will not be admitted; Motion in Limine No. 5 (Derogatory E-mails)

(docket #171) be and is DENIED to the extent that any e-mails referencing the defendants as "spammers" will be admitted; Motion in Limine No. 6 (Daniel Bohan) (docket #172) be and is GRANTED; and Motion in Limine No. 7 (Evidence on Topics Covered by 30(b)(6) Depositions) be and is DENIED. All such Motions in Limine are granted or denied without prejudice, and it is further ORDERED that plaintiffs be and are considered private figures for this civil action.

Accordingly, the defamation claims of Omega World Travel, Inc., Cruise.com, Inc., and Gloria Bohan will proceed for a trial by jury on Wednesday, April 25, 2007, at 10:00 a.m. on the issue of whether the defendants' statements were made negligently. Punitive damages will also be available if the plaintiffs prove actual malice by clear and convincing evidence.

The Clerk is directed to forward copies of this Order to counsel of record.
